German philosopher, born 1929

Lived through WWII. Active in philosophy and social theory since the 1960s.

Well-known for his theory of the public sphere and "communicative rationality."


Asks: how to make a just, humane society? Reason.


The Structural Transformation of the Bourgeois Public Sphere Published in 1962 – widely discussed in US after 1989

A work of history and social theory, aiming to explain the emergence of a "public sphere."

The "public sphere" – a space between private life and government where people could come together and form public opinion

Emerged in 18th, based in institutions such as newspapers, salons, coffee houses
